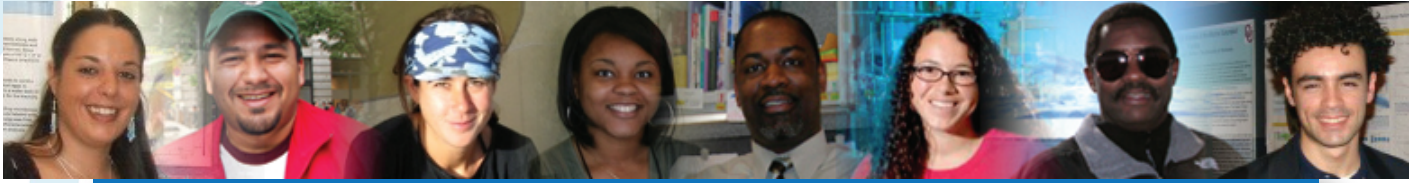

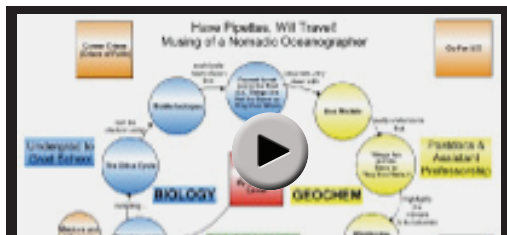


COSEE-OS and the Institute for Broadening Participation are pleased to share resources that aim to help under-represented students and young faculty enter the field of ocean sciences.

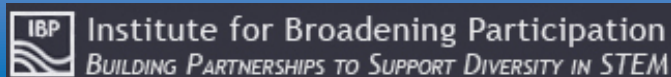
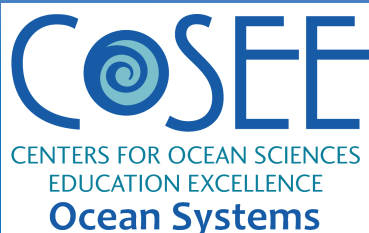
